New Recipient Requirements

Requirement 1: Recipient must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Recipient attends and is on track to graduate from a high school in Nueces County
- or Recipient is Active Military or a Veteran living or working in Nueces County
- or Parent/Guardian of recipient has been an active member in the Nueces County A&M Club since 2019 (i.e. has paid membership dues for 2019, 2020, and 2021)

Requirement 2: Recipient has been accepted and enrolled to Texas A&M University in College Station as a full time student for the 2022-2023 academic school year

Ongoing Recipient Requirements

Requirement 1: Enrolled at Texas A&M University in College Station as a full time student Requirement 2: Remained in good academic standing (>=2.75 cumulative GPA at the end of the semester)
